Upon inquiring of the two other vendors on the vendor list ("Intermountain Slurry Seal" and "A-1 Chipseal Company") as to why they did not submit a bid, both vendors stated that Larimer Count puts out our solicitation too late. They get busy this time of year and are unable to fit Larimer County in their schedule. Vance Bothers also indicated that we put our solicitation out late and they are the only company who can accommodate us with such late notice. In order to promote competition the Purchasing Department suggests the Road & Bridge Department send their request for bid to the Purchasing Department in February of each year; so as to give all the vendors an opportunity to submit a bid.

When you have completed your review of the bid, please prepare your recommendation on this form and return the form to me. If you do not recommend awarding the bid to the single vendor, please explain why. This document will be considered a public record and open to inspection.
