Transmitted for your review and recommendation is the one bid received to consider the purchase and pick-up of approximately 315,732 gallons of emulsified asphalt in 2014.

The Purchasing Department advertised on line and in the local newspaper, as well as directly solicited four (4) vendors for this bid; Cobitco Inc, Mountain States Materials, Suncor Energy, and Vance Brothers. Only one bid was received. The Purchasing Department followed up with the three vendors that did not bid to understand why. Vance Brothers only applies this product but does not sell it. Mountain States Materials was too busy to submit a bid this year and asked to be included on the bid next time. Cobitco Inc. submitted a "No Bid". The Purchasing Department contacted Cobitco Inc to see why they chose not to bid this year. Douglas Martin, Sales Manager at Cobitco Inc, stated that since Cobitco Inc. is not a manufacturer of this product, he could not guarantee the availability and therefore did not want to take on the \$1,000.00 per day liquidated damages liability as stated on page four (4) of the bid document.

When you have completed your review of the bid, please prepare your recommendation on this form and return the form to me. This document will be considered a public record and open to inspection.
