After interviewing all three vendors, the Larimer County Planning Department recommends accepting the proposal from EnerGov Solutions in the amount of \$573,857.00 (pending negotiations) per the attached departmental recommendation.

Explain why you want to award the work to a particular vendor and the dollar amount of the award:

The Evaluation Committee selects EnerGov in the amount of \$573,857.00 (pending negotiations) for the following reasons:

- 1) Energov's primary search function provides more capabilities, such as filtering and grouping functionality, to further refine the search results without re-doing the primary search. This functionality was not demonstrated by the other two short listed vendors.
- 2) Energov allows for GIS updates of polygon attributes directly from the application, allowing for the data to be readily available for parcel polygon genealogy. None of the other vendors demonstrated this functionality.
- 3) Energov scored the highest on the functional requirements matrix versus the other two short-listed vendors.
