No decision of award was made pending review and recommendation by the Larimer County Engineering Department. The Evaluation Committee reviewed the proposals received and made the decision to short-list the two top-scoring vendors; AECOM Technical Services and J-U-B Engineers, Inc.


On December 10, 2012, the two short-listed vendors provided the Evaluation Committee with a brief presentation of their approach to the project and answered questions.

Upon completion of the interviews and discussion by the Evaluation Team, it was unanimously decided that the award should be made to AECOM Technical Services, Inc, per the attached departmental recommendation. The cost for the Design Services for Bridge Replacement on CR 50 over the Larimer and Weld Canal will be negotiated between the Larimer County Engineering Department and AECOM Technical Services, Inc.

The following criteria must be used to evaluate the proposals:

- 1. Proposal Review 10%
- 2. Project Approach 20%
- 3. Project Team 30%
- 4. Firm Capability 25%
- 5. Project Completion 15%

This document will be considered a public record and open to inspection. The individual committee score sheets, comment sheets and other evaluation notes are DELIBERATIVE PROCESS records and not public records. Please keep these documents in your files.

Explain why you want to award the work to a particular vendor and the dollar amount of the award: After interviewing the two top-scoring vendors, the Evaluation Committee unanimously selected AECOM for the following reasons: AECOM is the only company interviewed that will do the bridge design in-house, and the project manager for their team is a bridge engineer, which we feel will benefit and expedite the coordination on this mostly bridge-replacement project. AECOM explored more conceptual alternatives in their proposal and presentation that showed a good ability to analyze all possible solutions, ultimately giving the County the best possible design. Alternatives included two roadway alignment options and three bridge alternatives with pros and cons listed for each, as well as discussions for the possibility of phased and accelerated bridge construction. Therefore, we feel AECOM brings together the best and most qualified design team to successfully complete this project for the County. This was a qualification only based selection, with no cost involved in this selection process.
