
No decision of award was made pending review and recommendation by the Larimer County Solid Waste Department.

The Evaluation Committee felt that both firms were highly qualified and exceptionally capable of providing the services as described in this Request for Proposal, however unanimously chose to select TFR Enterprises, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000.00, for the following reasons:

- 1) TFR has experience working with the 2013 Colorado Floods in Boulder, Adams and Weld Counties.
- 2) Of the two shortlisted vendors, TFR's proposal was the lowest priced.
- 3) TFR was the highest scored vendor of all proposals received.
