
The following criteria must be used to evaluate the proposals:

The evaluation committee individually scored the two (2) proposals received and unanimously chose to short-list Baldwin Demolition; clarifying questions were sent to Baldwin Demolition. After reviewing the responses, the committee unanimously selects Baldwin Demolition for award, in the estimated amount of \$62,088.68, for the following reasons. Only the proposal provided by Baldwin Demolition provided clear and concise steps for their Demolition Management and Safety Plan including pollution prevention, operational planning, recordation, and project preparation. Only the proposal provided by Baldwin Demolition evidenced that the project manager for this project has previous FEMA funded project experience.
