Cost	Rank this contractor's unit price for each item identified in the fee schedule and their manpower and equipment rates against the other proposals received.	30%
Qualifications	Does the vendor have the appropriate management personnel (superintendent), equipment, and company structure to successfully complete the various services for the PID with minimal County oversight?	20%
Management Ability	Does the vendor describe their plan and/or past experience in establishing a working relationship with a PID or other boards?	10%
