Conformity to the Specifications.	Do the detailed drawings and detailed specifications conform to specification?	20%
Past performance with this and other agencies	Does the contractor's proposal list similar projects they have completed? Does the reference and description of previous projects show past project of similar specifications?	20%
Ability to service this vehicles	Does the vendor have a support facility that is advantageous to Larimer County?	20%
