 - Expand campground programs to Pinewood Res
- Colorado Big Thompson Project Interpretation

 - 1 panel with fixed scope on nest



Education and Interpretation Opportunities

- Pinewood Reservoir Natural Playscape
 - Locate near entrance to walk-in sites
 - Tie-in to Osprey Interpretation
 - Intended for on-site visitors



Project Budget

- ◎ ~\$868,000 Total Cost
- ◎ \$100,000 from Open Lands
- ◎ \$170,000 from BOR




