Senior Management Team
 The management team is chaired by the Department Director, and includes the Open Lands Manager, the Visitor Services Manager, the Administrative Services Manager, and the Land Stewardship Program Manager. This group meets regularly to discuss and to provide input to the Director on topics of interest and concern to the Department.

Resource Stewardship Team
 Purpose: To meet regularly to discuss, communicate, coordinate resource management activities and make recommendations and/or decisions on visitor management that relate to a resource management issue.

1. To ensure that resource management plans are being carried out effectively and appropriately per the specific property plan.
2. To ensure that resource management activities are coordinated within the Department.
3. To discuss, as a group, proposed projects and management issues on Natural Resources properties.
4. To provide support to one another in completing resource stewardship activities.
5. To provide support and a forum for discussion of visitor management issues as they relate to resource protection.
