Re: Technical Revision to the Larimer County Urban Area Street Standard (LCUASS)

To the Development and Consultant Community:

This letter is to inform you of an update to the Larimer County Urban Area Street Standards (LCUASS) pertaining to portions of Chapter 16 (Pedestrian Facilities), Chapter 22 (Materials and Construction Specifications), Chapter 25 (Reconstruction and Repair), and Appendix A (Standard Drawings).

The updates are applicable within the Loveland and Fort Collins City limits as well as within their adopted Growth Management Areas. In a combined effort, the entities updated portions of these sections of the Standards in order to make corrections, reflect current industry standards and provide clearer and more detailed guidance.

This technical revision is not anticipated to result in any significant additional cost to persons affected by the revision and meets the technical revision criteria set forth in LCUASS Section 1.6.2.B.
