

Thousand Cankers Disease

Thousand cankers disease (TCD) of black walnut trees is a fungal disease that is carried from tree to tree by the walnut twig beetle. The walnut twig beetle is a native insect of the SW United States and has very little effects on the native walnut trees of that area, the Arizona walnut. The affects of TCD on black walnut trees in Colorado is almost always fatal. Sanitation is the key to not spreading this disease.
