1. Materials must have been generated from your own personal household, not a business.
2. Absolutely **NO SMOKING!**
3. Keep materials in original containers if at all possible.
4. Do not mix materials, and pack wastes carefully. Use sturdy cardboard boxes to transport wastes. **NO GARBAGE BAGS!**
5. Leave children at home if possible. **NO PETS ALLOWED.**
6. Shirts and shoes required for your safety.
