BACKGROUND:

The passage of House Bill 10-068, effective January 1, 2011, implemented several eligibility determination changes for the Colorado Works program.

The State Department of Human Services determined that children who are included in the Colorado Works basic cash assistance grant, and who have not yet reached the age of 18, do not need to be immunized in accordance with the Federal Childhood Immunization Schedule for eligibility determination.

POLICY:

At the time of application, the county department shall provide information concerning immunizations to all applicants seeking benefits through the Colorado Works program. The information shall include parental education of vaccines, information concerning where to access vaccines in the local community, and the exemptions listed in Section 25-4-903, C.R.S. The Larimer County Department of Health & Environment shall be the source of information for the immunization information for the Benefits Planning Division. The content of the information will be subject to an annual review of requirements for the Colorado Works program.
