



When Can You Make a Reservation?

- ◆ No closer than one day prior to arrival date when using a credit card (or 15 days for checks and money orders). Example: For a Friday arrival, Thursday is the last day to make a credit card reservation.
- ◆ No earlier than 180 days prior to arrival date
- ◆ Online 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- ◆ Phone (MST)
 Oct. - Mar.: 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Mon.-Fri.
 Apr. - Sept.: 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Mon.-Fri.
 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Sat.-Sun.

What Are the Fees?

- ◆ Reservation fee: \$8.75 per site or cabin, per camping trip, non-refundable
- ◆ Change or cancellation fee: additional \$6.35 per reservation
- ◆ Payment required for camping permits at the time of reservation (see “Prices”)
- ◆ Payment required for park entrance permits at the time of arrival (see “Prices”)
- ◆ Walk-in camping fee: \$2.50/site or cabin

What Are the Rules?

- ◆ Two-night minimum required on weekends April-October at all campsites, May-September at Hermit Park Open Space, and all year for Airstream at Horsetooth Reservoir County Park
- ◆ Three-night minimum required at all campsites on holiday weekends of Memorial Day, Labor Day and July 4 (if it falls on a Fri., Sat., Sun. or Mon.)
- ◆ No minimum stay for camper cabins at Horsetooth Reservoir County Park
- ◆ Maximum stay: 14 days in any 30-day period, anywhere in the system
- ◆ No sliding: Reservations made with a departure date beyond the 180-day advance reservations window may not be changed or cancelled until 18 days after the reservation is made. This rule is in place to give everyone equal opportunity to reserve the campsite in advance.
- ◆ Five reservations is the maximum per phone call or web session.

What Are the Prices?

Camping Permits: per site, per night

October - March

Non-electric & electric campsite:	\$15
