- ◆ Elevation of 5,430 feet
- ◆ 2,040 acres of water + 1,900 acres of public lands
- ◆ 6.5 miles long, 212 feet deep at deepest point
- ◆ Open year-round
- ◆ Fishing, boating, camping, picnicking, swimming, water-skiing, rock climbing
- ◆ Great fishing: walleye, smallmouth bass, perch, trout and other species
- ◆ 7 waterfront cabins available year-round plus Airstream trailer available May to Sept.
- ◆ Full-service marina: (970) 223-0140

Regulations to Help Us Serve You

- ◆ Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
 - ◆ Only 3.2% alcohol is allowed. Glass and kegs are prohibited.
 - ◆ Pets must be leashed at all times (10 ft. max.) and must not be left unattended.
 - ◆ Camping is in designated campsites only.
 - ◆ Homeland Security prohibits recreation on dams. Stay 100 feet away from dams when on land - no restrictions from water.

Entrance Permits

- ◆ Required of all visitors at all times
- ◆ Annual Entrance Permits - valid for a year from month of purchase, transferable among vehicles registered to the same household. Buy at entrance stations, nearby retail outlets, or online: www.larimer.org/naturalresources

Vehicle (includes non-trailer watercraft)

Larimer County resident:	\$75
Non-resident:	\$95
Senior:	\$45
Disabled:	\$10

Combo (vehicle + trailer watercraft)

Larimer County resident:	\$150
Non-resident:	\$190
Senior:	\$120
Disabled:	\$85

(slipped and moored marina customers must purchase combo permit)

- ◆ Daily Entrance Permits - valid day of purchase until noon the next day. Buy at entrance stations and self-serve stations.

Reservoirs: \$7/vehicle or \$7/boat trailer only; or \$14 vehicle + boat trailer

All other areas: \$6/vehicle

Campsites & Cabins

- ◆ April - September

Full hookup:	\$30
Non-electric:	\$15
Electric:	\$25
2nd camping unit at site:	\$10
Camper cabin:	\$60
Airstream:	\$99
- ◆ October - March




