### **What do you like?**

- Snow removal is fantastic
- Impressed with care of the roads in general
- The wildlife
- The quiet and peacefulness
- Proximity to the city
- Ability for hunters to exist in the area for animal population control
- Quality of life
- There are activities that one can participate in
- Would like to compliment everyone on services from the flood

### **What do you want?**

- Some form of bus service, similar to the Larimer Lift or Loveland Saint, Colton Fox, etc., would be nice especially for the aging populous
- Education to bicyclists in the area and notification of planned bike races. The notifications are on-line but that is not helpful if you don't have good internet service
- Finding information on how to get help from the County is difficult. This needs to be easier. There needs to be some education on what County services are available and how to obtain the services. That could be improved. The website search bar need improvement. Need to know what people can really do by adding information on land use and rules
- Want information that links descriptions of services available to how they are paid for in a simple format that people can easily find and understand

### **What needs to be improved or changed?**

- Need better internet service in the rural area
- Need senior services, such as a recreation center or at least let the rural visitors join places like the Chilson Center with a membership
- Fire and emergency services response time is a problem
- Need a rural board of neighbors that can discuss issues. Move County board meetings and services out of Fort Collins and into more of the rural areas
- Run outreach effort like a campaign—use telephone calls and voter registration lists to get out e-mails
